Following the launch of the Community Plan in April 2016 we have been busy promoting opportunities for funding to local community groups & organisations. This is through our theme budgets & small grants programme.






We have been working with Litter Watch to supply **FREE** skips for residents to dispose of unwanted items. Look out for the leaflets for dates when a skip is in **your** area.
